Global background color	<code>body { background: [hex or rgb]; }</code>		Used to change background color from light grey to something else. We typically recommend retaining the default.
Global typeface	<code>body { font-family: [typefaces]; }</code>		Impacts all text. Default is Lucida Grande. Changing this can create some spacing issues.
Flexible branding - top	<code>#flex-branding-top { background: [hex or rgb]; }</code>		Inactive by default. When activated, inserts an image above the standard header.
Flexible branding - bottom	<code>#flex-branding-bottom { background: [hex or rgb]; }</code>		Inactive by default. When activated, inserts an image beneath standard content.
Standard header	<code>header { background: [hex or rgb]; }</code>		This is active by default and generally contains the event organizer's logo. We typically update the background property to match the logo.
Global announcement	<code>#announce-global { background [hex or rgb]; color: [hex or rgb]; }</code>		This is a message which appears at the very top of the page. By default, it is inactive. You can set background color and text color.
Session header	<code>#header-session { background: [hex or rgb]; }</code>		An additional bar which appears as a header for a session, with text indicating which session a user is in.
Session header text	<code>#header-session h1 a { color: [hex or rgb]; }</code>		This is the text inside the session header. This is how you change the text color.
Session header text (no ellipsis)	<code>#header-session h1 a { text-overflow: clip; white-space: normal; }</code>		This code will override the default styling, and allow a Session Title to wrap across multiple lines.
Section headers	<code>.section-header { background: [hex or rgb]; }</code>		There are a number of sections with contain links to various things. At the top of the list is a header bar.
Section header text	<code>.section-header h1 { color: [hex or rgb]; text-shadow: none; }</code>		Changing the color of a link list header requires another line of code . You may want to change both the color and text-shadow.
Section header action links	<code>.section-header a { background: [hex or rgb]; color: [hex or rgb]; text-shadow: none; }</code>		There are occasionally action links that appear to the right of the header text. For example, we might have a "Create" or "new" link.
Section header action link hover state	<code>.section-header a: hover { background: [hex or rgb]; }</code>		Yes, these links have a hover state as well
Poll list header	<code>#dashboard-polls .section-header { background: [hex or rgb]; color: [hex or rgb]; text-shadow: none; }</code>		Polls are a special kind of link list but can be overridden similarly.
Poll list action link	<code>#dashboard-polls .section-header a { background: [hex or rgb]; color: [hex or rgb]; border-left-color: [hex or rgb]; text-shadow: none; }</code>		This is the "Create Poll" button that moderators can see. You may also need to change the left border color.
Poll instructions	<code>#dashboard-polls .section-instructions { background: [hex or rgb]; color: [hex or rgb]; }</code>		Attendees see these instructions when polls are visible.
Social Q&A list header	<code>#dashboard-questions .section-header { background: [hex or rgb]; color: [hex or rgb]; text-shadow: none; }</code>		Social Q&A are a special kind of link list but can be overridden similarly.
Social Q&A list action link	<code>#dashboard-questions .section-header a { background: [hex or rgb]; color: [hex or rgb]; border-left-color: [hex or rgb]; text-shadow: none; }</code>		This is the "Ask" button that attendees can see. You may also need to change the left border color;
Social Q&A instructions	<code>#dashboard-questions .section-instructions { background: [hex or rgb]; color: [hex or rgb]; }</code>		Attendees see these instructions when Social Q&A is visible.
Social Q&A no upvote	<code>#dashboard-questions .vote { display: none !important; }</code>		Takes away the ability for participants to upvote
Social Q&A Remove "X"	<code>#dashboard-questions .utility.remove { display: none !important; }</code>		Takes away the ability for moderators to delete a question
Moderator Sign In button	<code>.btn-moderator-login</code>		This is for the sign-in button itself
Session Dashboard - Announcement Heading	<code>#dashboard-announcement h2 { display: none; }</code>		To hide the announcement, use the CSS rule "display: none;"

This uses the "Custom Head" section.
Social Q&A, Presenter 'prefix' adjustment	<pre> <script> var custom_labels = { session_dashboard_social_qa_presenter_prefix: "for" }; </script> </pre>		Change the text (in quotations) to customize the text that normally says "for" as the prefix before a presenter's name when the Social Q&A Panel feature is enabled.. This uses the "Custom Head" section.
Session Evaluation - Choose Another Session button	<code>.btn-choose-another-session</code>		When this is updated, it is typically to hide it (for various reasons)
Go Back Button	<code>.btn-inverse</code>		Button at top of page after attendee responds to poll
Redirect Header Image Link to Separate URL	<pre> <script> \$(document).ready(function(){ \$("header h1 a").attr("href", "new URL here"); }); </script> </pre>		Add to Custom Head Section and Replace "New URL here"
Unlink Header Image (No redirect to homepage)	<pre> <script> \$(document).ready(function(){ \$("header h1 a").attr("href", "#"); }); </script> </pre>		Add to Custom Head Section

Date/Time Headers Admin/Moderator Setting Headers	<pre>#main .link-list h1 { background: [hex or rgb]; }</pre>		Background color for Admin setting labels, Moderator setting labels, and date/time headers on multi-session apps.
